## More Than Conquerors

### Review:

1. Read Romans 8:31-39
2. What is the main idea of the passage?
3. What was the main idea of the message?

### Application:

1. Saylorville Church has been described as “a church that Satan takes notice of.” What is the basis of this description? What are some of the potential risks and rewards of being in Satan’s crosshairs as a church?
2. Read Romans 8:31-39 as a group. Why do you think this is considered one of the most encouraging examples in all of Scripture?
3. Are there times in your life where you have felt that God has left you or doesn’t love you? Why? How did you overcome that?
4. Discuss a time when you felt overwhelmed by your circumstances. What promises from this passage can give you security during a similar experience in the future?
5. Security doesn’t minimize our struggles, it maximizes our Savior. How have you experienced and/or observed the truth of this statement?
6. Jason Jackson used a lake analogy to describe our lives in relation to our circumstances, stating that all of us are: (1) about to be tossed into the lake, (2) floating in the middle of the lake, (3) drowning in the middle of the lake or (4) about to be pulled out of the lake. Where do you see yourself currently in this analogy? Why?
7. What does it mean to be “more than conquerors,” as referenced in Romans 8:37?
8. Pray together, thanking God for loving us so much that He will never let us go!
