Review:

1. Read 2 Corinthians 3:7-11
2. What is the main idea of the passage?
3. What was the main idea of the message?

Application:

1. What was most challenging from the message?
2. How would you define the word “glory?” When was the last time you experienced glory in the spiritual sense?
3. 2 Corinthians 3:7-9 refers to the ministry of death and the ministry of condemnation. How is it that death and condemnation can be ministries? What does it mean to receive the ministry of death and condemnation?
4. How does the law serve us today? What is the purpose of the “light” the law gives us?
5. Is your life today more defined by fear or by freedom? Why? What is keeping you looking over your shoulder in fear?
6. Describe how your story/testimony is an example of surpassing glory? In what ways are you reflecting that surpassing glory today?
7. What does your face reflect lately? Time with God? Struggles of life? Sin?
8. When did you first realize and understand your desperate position apart from Jesus? How did you respond and how long did it take for you to respond?
9. Are you an apatheist? Why are you living this way? What will cause it to change?
