Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

- To encourage our young people to attend a college or university that will teach and reinforce a Christian worldview that is in line with the doctrine of Saylorville Church.
- To financially support our young people in their pursuit of Christian ministry.
- To maintain contact with our young people as they pursue a college degree.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Church Membership:
 - a. If you are under the age of 18, you must be a faithful participant in Saylorville Students **and** have parents that are faithful members at Saylorville Church.
OR
 - b. If you are 18 or older, you must be a faithful member at Saylorville Church.
2. Enrollment Status:
 - a. Be a full-time student (undergraduate)
OR
 - b. be a part-time or full-time student (graduate/seminary).
3. Maintain a GPA of 2.50 or better.
4. All recipients must be attending a Christian college or university whose doctrine is in line with the doctrine of Saylorville Church to receive the scholarship.
5. Exceptions to these requirements will be considered on an individual basis.

AWARDS

Our desire is to provide as many scholarships as possible, if we receive more applications than we can support, scholarship funds will be prioritized to upperclassmen pursuing a ministry related degree. Scholarships will be awarded annually in the following increments:

UNDERGRADUATE	Ministry Related Degree*	Non-Ministry Related Degree ⁺
Amount Per Year	\$1,000	\$500

***Examples of Ministry Related Degrees** - Pastoral/Pre-seminary, Biblical Studies, Biblical Counseling, Worship Ministry, Youth Ministry, Children’s Ministry, Missions, Women’s Ministry, etc.

***Examples of Non-Ministry Related Degrees** - Business, Engineering, Nursing, Education, Communication, etc.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application on the following page must be completed and returned to the church office by **June 1st** to be considered for the upcoming school year. The Pastors and Deacons will review and process applications and make recommendations in awarding scholarships.

Scholarships will be awarded in the summer and based on the previous year GPA. Checks will be sent directly to the school with reference to the student receiving the funds.

Exceptions to the application deadline will be considered by the Pastors and Deacons on an individual basis.

FOLLOW-UP

Once a year, scholarship recipients must provide a written or verbal update to the Pastors and Deacons on their academic progress, spiritual growth, and future plans.

FUNDS

Funds for this scholarship will be budgeted and distributed as available from our Leadership Development budget as a part of the Leadership Development Pipeline.

CHURCH CONTACT
