CONNECT WITH YOUR GROUP (10-15 MINUTES)

- Jason joked about springtime making him want to spend money. What's one area of life where you're most tempted to ignore biblical wisdom and simply do what feels right in the moment?
- When you hear the statement, "The Bible is God's Word and the final authority for my life," what emotions or reactions rise up in you?

APPLY THE BIBLE (45-60 MINUTES)

- **Remember** what you talked about last time. Is there anything you need to **follow up** on this week?
- **Review** your Sermon Notes together. What is **one thing** that sticks out to you about what you learned?
- **Read** this week's passage together. In his message, Pastor Jason challenged us to move from information to transformation when it comes to our response to the truth.

GOod DOctrine...**1. Pursues What Is Profitable (Titus 3:9)**

- Paul warns believers to avoid "foolish controversies." What kinds of arguments or distractions tend to consume Christians today?
- Why are people often drawn toward online debates, theological arguments, gossip, or controversy?
- What is one practical way you can personally spend less time on distractions and more time pursuing what is spiritually profitable?

2. Protects God's People (Titus 3:10-11)

- Why does Paul (and Jesus) treat divisiveness so seriously within the family of God?
- Jason said, "Ignoring destructive behavior in another Christian is not love." Do you agree? Why or why not? Can you think of personal examples?
- Are there any relationships in your life that need reconciliation, honesty, forgiveness, or healthy confrontation?

3. Prioritizes Gospel Partnership (Titus 3:12-13)

- At first glance, these verses feel like travel details. What do they actually reveal about the way ministry worked in the early church? Where else do we see that principle in the New Testament?
- Why is Christianity dangerous when it becomes isolated and individualistic?
- Who has invested in you? How might God be calling you to invest in someone else this week?

3. Produces Spiritual Fruit (Titus 3:14-15)

- Why is a transformed life such a powerful witness in today's culture?
- What would submission to God's Word look like in your life right now?
- Read James 1:22-25. What warning and encouragement do these verses give to believers?

Receive and Respond: What will I do because of what I just heard?

PRAY TOGETHER (5-15 MINUTES)

- As a group, pray for hearts that are soft, humble, and responsive to God's Word.
